But:

IDL> print, !version { x86_64 linux unix linux 8.0 Jun 18 2010 64 64} IDL> groups = !null IDL> foreach g, groups do help, g % Variable is undefined: GROUPS. % Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$

This must be a fix in 8.0.1. I will do some more research, but sheds some light on the original situation that was causing me some problems debugging.
