- > cgtext,1,1,'This should be vertical',orient=90,window=window

- > end

Whoops! Same problem as this morning. In cgTEXT, line 175, when calling cgWINDOW, the _REF_EXTRA=extra call *has* be set to _EXTRA=extra. Otherwise, extra keywords cannot be recognized by CALL_PROCEDURE.

I've made the change here, and I'll check the rest of my routines to be sure I've found it everywhere. Update later today, with new programmable ability to make raster files from cgWindow, complements of Jeremy, who had this done in about 15 minutes!
