- > about it.

> If you want to use PS_Start, just set your sizes with it:

>

> PS_Start, /NoMatch, XSIZE=5, YSIZE=5, /Inches, FILE='test.ps'

>

> Then, don't mess around changing anything. :-)

If you *do* want to muck around, set the /GUI keyword to PS_Start and you can muck around in PSConfig for as long as you like. PS_END will still know about it. :-)
