- Yes, I downloaded today: coyoteprograms & coyote2ndfiles. Don't seem to be the same problem as yesterday.
  And, I assume you are saying the PostScript file has the text, but the PNG file does not. Is that correct?
  Yes
  There really is no reason to use PS\_START if you are going to do all of this. This is sort of the point of PS\_START. It will set
  all this stuff up for you.
- OK, I suspect this is the problem then. PS\_END, which will create the PNG file from the PostScript file, relies on information created in PS\_Start. Like, for example, the size of the output. So, if you are circumventing PS\_Start to create your own sizes, PS\_End won't know about it.

> Sure, in fact I just need to fix xsize and ysize

If you want to use PS\_Start, just set your sizes with it:

PS\_Start, /NoMatch, XSIZE=5, YSIZE=5, /Inches, FILE='test.ps'

Then, don't mess around changing anything. :-)
