you can try this little sed command on the data to generate non-broken files:
(all needs to go into one line)

```
sed <asdf.tab -e 's/\t\t\t\t0\t/g' -e 's/\t\t\t0\t/g' -e 's/\t\t\t0\t/g' -e 's/\t$/\t0/g'
```

asdf.tab:

```
1 2 3 4  
2 3  
3 5 5
```

result:

```
1 2 3 4  
2 0 0 3  
3 5 5 0
```
