I agree that some type of routine like David's FIND_RESOURCE_FILE is extremely useful. Also, note that you can expand notation like '~' and '..' using FILE_EXPAND_PATH:

IDL> $pwd
```

```

```
IDL> print, file_expand_path(' ../../')
```

```
/Users/mgalloy/projects
```
