Yep. IDL for Windows doesn't officially support long filenames. Appalling but true.

> [Re .PRO files]

Bill Thompson wrote a CONCAT4DOS routine that concatenates & renames .PRO files to fit in the 8.3 limitation. I have a modified version that runs under WinNT (& probably Win95). Contact me if you want a copy.

- Also I've noticed that I cannot OPENW a file that doesn't have an
- > 8.3 form. The only way to do it is to assign the filename I want to
- > use to a string variable and then OPENW using the variable as the
- > file name parameter. Although this is not a critical flaw, it \*is\*
- > annoying.

I didn't know about that workaround. I have found adding a space to the end of file names does the trick.

- > Does anyone know of any patches/updates to 4.0.1 for WinNT/Win95 that
- > will give IDL the full long filename capability?

One hopes it will be fixed in version 5.
