- > border it seems to encounter an error that causes it to draw contour
- > lines where they should not be (e.g., between two values that I have
- > specified to be within the same contour level interval. For example, I
- > specify 0, 0.1, 0.2, etc... and it draws a line between locations with
- > values of 0.13 and 0.14.

- > MAP\_SET is called, but otherwise I can find no reasoning for the
- > location of this error at the 48th parallel.

>

> Anyone ever seen something like this?

I have occasionally seen something like this, although I have never been able to prove it is happening. There are many things that can go wrong, however, when you put a contour on a map projection, so I would like to see the code before I make a judgement. If we can eliminate the obvious problems it is possible that what is left might be interesting. :-)
