> x = randomu(seed, 100)
> y = randomu(seed, 100)
> z = randomu(seed, 100)
> oobj = obj_new('orb')
> p = plot3d(x, y, z, sym_object = oorb)
>
> PLOT3D: Unknown property: SYM_OBJECT
> Execution halted at: \$MAIN\$
>
> This is surprising because the SYM_OBJECT property is described
> in the documentation for PLOT3D()
>
> Is this the bug that I think it is, or am I doing something
> wrong?
