> 15 16 17
>

> What is the IDL Way to remove rows 2 and 5?
>

> subarray = ???
> print, subarray
>

> 0 1 2
> 6 7 8
> 9 10 11
> 15 16 17

subarray=array[*,[0,2,3,5]]
