I have other things demanding my attention this morning, so I thought I would offer an IDL challenge. What is the IDL Way to remove arbitrary rows of an array?

For example, suppose I have this array:

```
array = Indgen(3,6)
print, array
```

```
0   1   2
3   4   5
6   7   8
9  10  11
12 13  14
15 16  17
```

What is the IDL Way to remove rows 2 and 5?

```
subarray = ???
print, subarray
```

```
0   1   2
6   7   8
9  10  11
15 16  17
```
