David Fanning writes:

- > (I used TortoiseSVN), then you make a project in
- > IDL out of that directory, the Subversion plug-in
- > does seem to work in this case.

Although, I should point out that I did manage to get my Coyote directory installed in IDL 8.1 in this way. But, when I went through the identical steps to get my Catalyst directory installed, IDL went into some kind of tail spin when it tried to make a project out of it. I let it churn for a couple of hours before I killed the process.

I haven't tried it again this morning, as I'm trying to get some work done and I always use IDL 7.1.1 for that. :-)
