OK, I fixed cgHistogram. You can find it here:

In cgHistogram I was calculating the min and max ranges for the plot in the variables xrange and yrange. I was creating the plot scaffolding for the histogram plot, by using the PLOT command like this:

Plot, xrange, yrange, ...

The fix was simply to create the plot like this:

Plot, [0,0], xrange=xrange, yrange=yrange, ...
