Lets suppose that i write your program (or any other program)

```
pro howdy  
  print, 'hello world'  
end
```

I save the program under the ...\\IDLWorkspace71 directory with the name howdy.

Now if i give the command from the command line

```
ENVI> howdy  
hello world  
ENVI>
```

As you see i dont have any error message.

NOW IF i press the F8 button (=start execution) then the result is

```
hello world!  
File does not exist: 'howdy.pro'.
```

Interesting.. It gives this message only when i press F8 OR CTRL+F8 (=compile the active source code).
