- > After some time trying to figure out what was going on, I eventually
- > found that the changes in some classes between 8.0.1 and 8.1 break
- > compatibility of some savefiles, in both ways: not only 8.1 savefiles
- > cause trouble when restored in 8.0.1, but also 8.0.1 savefiles cause
- > trouble when restored in 8.1

It has been pointed out to me that this is one of the cases that can be solved with restore's `/relaxed_structure_assignment` keyword (which can suggestively be abbreviated as `/relax`). The classes are compatible enough that restore can instantiate the native class and copy the data fields by name.
