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You may think I keep beating this dead bug. But I do it only because ITTVIS seems to allow it to keep living. I just had to tell another user that, because hardware rendering was not available, the only way to use Graphics was through command line. And that was after fixing the (even older) `gl_driver.so` bug (Tech Tip 1737), which was keeping everything from working.

I just noticed David's article on this ([http://www.idlcoyote.com/ng\\_tips/render.php](http://www.idlcoyote.com/ng_tips/render.php)). I would add to it only that ITTVIS' Tech Tip is very discouraging:

"Fedora, Ubuntu and OpenSUSE

Under these systems, that includes: Fedora 12 and 13, Ubuntu 9.04, 9.10 and 10.04, and OpenSUSE 11.2, the activation of Xinerama using the `xorg.conf` file will not fix the Software Rendering problem, and it's not recommended because it may cause additional problems.

(...)

The solution in these cases (i.e. when using these open source systems), is to make use of the Command Line IDL when users need to use Software Rendering in their workflow."

Really? "solution"?

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
