Subject: Starting location in histoplot?

I'm trying to compare two different samples using the histoplot command. My problem is that the two different histograms (sample 1 and sample 2) are slightly offset from each other. This is due to the two samples having slightly different minimum values. I'm plotting from 0-100, in one sample the minimum value is say 1 and in the other its say 3. If I set the binsize to 5 for both, the first histogram location is 1-6 while the second is 3-8. I would like these to be the same, by specifying an initial starting point of 0. So for both sets the first bin goes from 0-5. Is this possible? I've noticed in the histoplot documentation there is an output keyword LOCATIONS which tells the starting location of each bin but I haven't found anything to set the location of the first bin.
