I am using the PS driver on Linux.

The hairlines may be "rendering artifacts," but they are definitely present, and the aliasing that comes with them does persist when the PS is converted to a PNG.

> The best solution I know of is to use an image instead of
> line graphics. You can control the resolution of the image
> and make it chunky or smooth, as you prefer.

I was driven to try this because I got fed up with the imprecision of my results using various image-based approaches.
