> work out how to do this. I can't see anything in the docs, and trying  
> things like an XSIZE and YSIZE parameter doesn't seem to do anything.  
>  
> Is there a way to do this? I'm pretty sure there would be, I just can't  
> seem to find it!

WXSIZ and WYSIZ. Should be in the docs. I'll check.  
Most cgWindow keywords start with a "W" to avoid  
conflicting with obvious keywords that will belong  
to the command you are entering into the window.
