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Hi Folks,

I'm using the DE in IDL 7.1 and I have some files (custom object definitions) that have many functions/procedures in them so I use the 'folding' of the text (not sure of the correct term, the things where you can click the circles with +/- on the left to hide the source code of a function/procedure).

The problem is that every time I open a file, the default is to have all functions unfolded and it is time consuming to click them all close so that I can more easily browse the file to work on different functions. Does anyone know if there is an option to have all of these closed when you open a new file? I couldn't find anything in the menus or help, but then again it's hard to guess what to search for when you don't know the proper name of the feature in question!
