> Is resizing in general just broken in Function Graphics
> windows? I can basically take any program I've written
> in the past couple of days and start resizing the window
> to get all kinds of strange and wonderful things to happen.
>
> In particular, with the program I am playing with right now,
> even though the color bar has been positioned with the
> POSITION keyword, it can appear nearly any place in the
> window. Sometimes its length fills up the entire window,
> sometimes it is WAY smaller than I intend, etc. No rhyme
> or reason to it that I can see. :-(
