> At least it was perfect until I tried to save the
> visualization as a PostScript file. Then there is
> a black rectangle that seems to be positioned behind
> the map projection. It doesn't show at all on the
> display, but clearly shows (and won't go away!) on
> the PostScript file. Presumably I didn't see the
> rectangle before because the equirectangular
> projection covers it up.
