It works not so much under NT, as NTFS. NT will run on either a FAT filesystem, or if you're not braindead you can set it up on the NTFS filesystem, which supports long names. NT's own files are 8.3 to support use on a FAT, but as long as you are using NTFS on a drive it should store long filenames quite happily. Do not try this on a FAT floppy, as it will get you precisely nowhere!

As to when will NT 5.0 be released, the answer is probably "when MS Marketing Department sees a good sales reason to make the next incremental release a major version number"...;-)
