- > I try to run a program that doesn't explicitly open
- > a graphics window, but just issues a graphics command
- > that is \*suppose\* to open a window (plot, contour, etc.)
- > that about every 5th or 6th time I run the program
- > nothing whatsoever happens

It is possible to see this in a positive light. For example, whenever it happens you can remind yourself to stretch your wrists to avoid repetitive strain injuries. Or, you can see it as a subtle reminder from ITTVIS to pay your maintenance fees. You can probably think of other positive things you can do. It is best, however, not to have a firearm nearby. :-)
