We use IDL 7.1 using the IDLDE for development on windows and Linux and then in batch mode for near real time data processing and visualisation. One of my colleagues attended your training course last week in Melbourne and mentioned all the nice features that IDL 8.1 has, such as list and hashes which I've hacked up implementations of as custom objects in 7.1 (which is therefore constrained by the horrible custom object syntax and memory mismanagement).
