Ok, ok. I think the problem really is that *all* encapsulated PostScript files need to be in Portrait mode. I've modified all my PostScript programs (i.e., PS_Start, PSConfig, etc) this morning to enforce this restriction. They should be checked in and available within the hour. I'm just doing the final quality checks now.
