- > datum = 'North America 1983'
- > OUT_proj = ENVI_PROJ_CREATE(DATUM=datum, /GEOGRAPHIC)

- > that fails as below when I invoke the procedure it seems strange
- > that the failure appears to be associated with ENVI's failure to find
- > an internal routine (MAP_PE_VALID_DATUM_NAME) required by
- > ENVI PROJ CREATE.

> Anyone have an idea of what might be happening?

I think you can reasonably expect this is a bug in the ENVI code. I'd check with ITTVIS about it.
