- > entity. So, if I have many entities (often the case in my shapefiles), I
- > have to instance many IDLanROI objects, generate a mask for all of them
- > and then combine the masks together? Or did I miss something again?

No, you can do all this with one IDLanROI object. Simply use the MASK_IN keyword to the Compute_Mask method to pass in and modify the mask from previous polygons.

Yes, the IDLanROI object is one of those game changers in IDL, once you learn of its existence. :-)
