To get a better idea of what ENVI's actually doing, I'd use ENVI_CONVERT_FILE_COORDINATES instead of relying on what you see in the Pixel Locator or Cursor Location/Value tools. File coordinates should be supplied to that procedure as zero-based numbers, so you'll be able to do a direct comparison to your approach.
