> software! I don't use an IDLanROI object there, because
> I want to do this myself and completely understand what
> I am doing. In *my* ROI, the [0.5,0.5] location would
> indeed be the center of the first pixel. I don't know
> off-hand what the IDLanROI object will do.

I think the PIXEL_CENTER keyword is going to provide you with control over this issue.
