```
> This will work for your original question:  
>  
> t = ['6x10!A-4!x', '7x10!A-4!x']  
> cgplot, [1e-10, 1], /ystyle, /ylog, ytickv = [6e-9, 7e-4], $  
> yticks = 1, ytickname=t, /window
```

Whoops! The variable t should be this, of course:

```
t = ['6x10!A-9!x', '7x10!A-4!x']
```
