Well, then I would replace the ON_ERROR, 2
call in Mean with this:

```
Catch, theError  
IF theError NE 0 THEN BEGIN  
    Catch, /CANCEL  
    void = Error_Message()  
    RETURN  
ENDIF
```

That will allow you to track the error.
