Unfortunately I always get the error message:

```
% IDLDOC: Attempt to subscript V2PARTS with I is out of range.

```

with idldoc-3.4! What's the problem?

And it still eats up a lot of memory, but I couldn't test it with our whole library (> 2000 files) due to the error above. idldoc-3.3 never could finish all files due to a memory crash of IDL (around 2 GB)! Is it somehow possible to split it up? E.g. use idldoc on certain folders and then merge the htmls?
