I don't understand: the "Overview" link takes you to the Overview page -- that is independent of whether you are using frames or not. The "single page"/"use frames" links takes you between the single page view or the frames; the only oddity is that "use frames" always takes you back to the overview page in frames (I had to do that so I wouldn't break the back button, i.e., one click on "use frames" would require two hits of the back button to back out of).
