I'm not much of an ENVI person, but I *think* you have execute those two ENVI commands from the IDL main-level. That is, not from inside a program module. (I seem to recall having the same problem once.)

The invalid widget identifier comes about when you try to use a widget identifier in a command and that widget no longer exists. This could happen, for example, if you saved a program that used widgets, then killed all the widgets. When you restore the program, you will have to re-create all the widgets and update the widget identifiers. Otherwise, this is exactly what can happen.
