> want to put a plot in the window, then later I want
> to put a contour plot in the window. I use commands
> something like this:
>
>   w = window()
>   w.select
>   p = plot(indgen(10),/CURRENT)
>   w.erase
>   c = contour(/test, /CURRENT)
```

The Delete method should do this, but it's working perhaps a bit too literally -- if I delete the plot, the axes remain. I think this is a bug, but the workaround is straightforward:

```
w = window()
p = plot(/test, /current)
foreach axis, p['axis*'] do axis.delete
p.delete
c = contour(/test, /current)
```
