Folks,

I spent the better part of a couple of hours yesterday documenting keywords in one of my programs. There are several program modules in this file. I have defined a module description and keyword parameters for all of them. When I run them through IDLDOC, three of the four modules look great. But the last module in the file refuses to document the keywords in the HTML file!

I have had this problem before if I don't get the indenting just right. But I have been ALL OVER this file and I am convinced the indenting in the last module is IDENTICAL to the indenting in the first three modules. I have also confirmed that I spelled ":Keywords": correctly.

Can anyone think of another reason I might not be seeing these keywords documented in the output documentation?
