Hi all

I have a quick question I hope you can help with. I have been making a plot with GDL, and it comes out as expected, with the axes in the ranges I want. However, when I use the exact same code with IDL, it refuses to accept the ranges I have specified. For example, with the following code

```
loadct, 0, /silent
plot, [0], [0], /nodata, xrange=[0,1200], yrange=[-90,90], $
yticks=6, xticks=10, $
color=0, background=255, $
xtitle='Time', ytitle='Latitude'
```

GDL plots fine, but IDL sets the x-axis to [-400,1600] and the y-axis to [-150,150]. Can anyone offer any insight as to why it works with GDL but not IDL??? It's beginning to annoy me now, especially since it will no doubt be something obvious!
