I guess many of us log their IDL session to keep track of the work. My question is whether it is possible to close the log file and make it read-only from within IDL? The journal command lacks a corresponding option. I just want to avoid that the file is being deleted/changed later on by accident.

If this cannot be done by IDL itself, I have to come up with a cronjob that checks the log folder for closed files which are still writable, and changes their attribute.
