> This statement does not create a variable but creates a string containing for example "im_1".

 You can convert a string to a variable with the execute statement

>

> status = execute("im_" + strtrim(temp,2) + "= mrdfits(files[i],0,h)")

>

> --Wayne

I rather guess that the compiler simply complains because your left hand side does not contain a named variable. You cannot store in it, whatever 'mrdfits' is doing.
