I have a weird one today!
Consider the following two lines of code:
cgplot, [0., 1.], [0., 1.]
cgplot, [0., 1.], [0.5, 0.5], /overplot, color='red'
The second, red, line should be drawn horizontally
though the middle of the plot.
Only, in IDL 8.1 on a Mac running OS X 10.7.2, it
is not. The red line is drawn *vertically*!
```

Nevermind. This turned out to be the result of an incorrectly synced library. When we started with a completely new download, all was well. :-)
