> my main file using ".compile circleidle" and it works. But i feel its
> not the proper way to use. Is there any other way to do this...?

The first problem with cgSnapshot is because you either haven't installed the complete Coyote Library, or you haven't put the Library on your IDL path correctly. Here is an article that describes how to do so:
