  the color:

  But, as I say, it is MUCH easier to just do this:

    p = plot(x, y, color='olive')
>

  If you grow tired of waiting for Function Graphics commands (it's
  possible!), you can do the same thing with Coyote Graphics
  commands, if you update your Coyote Library:

    cgPlot, x, y, color='olive', /Window
>
