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Hello,

I am looking for a cyan to blue to white to red to yellow color palette similar to the one here:

Specifically I am looking for a 256 version of the white_centered.spk palette from Ferret. It is my understanding that Ferret interpolates the colors from the following:

```
0   0 100 100
20  20 20 100
35 100 100 100
65 100 100 100
80 100 20 20
100 100 100 0
```

I believe the first column is the percentage value, but I am just not sure how to use on 6 RGB values to get a full color palette I can use in IDL.

Any assistance would be greatly appreciated.
