Hi all,

I have a couple of questions regarding Java bridge:

First: I was able to run all my scripts successfully in standard IDL server mode, however now the guys I work with have added some parts of the code that also needs ENVI.

I was wondering if any of you has any experience with running the Java/IDL bridge in ENVI + IDL mode. Is it even possible to do it?

Second: I have tried to run two separate asynchronous java threads which call 2 different IDL functions. However when I check the resources the code is always executed in sequence - i.e. one of the processes always waits for the second one to finish. I have also checked the processes in the Task Manager and it appears that only one idl\_opserver process is created for both threads. Is there any way/flag to tell the IDL to start two separate idl\_opserver processes which would run in parallel?
