Here are a couple of Coyote Library updates that may be important to you.

cgHistoplot -- I added a LOG keyword so the histogram count can be specified on a logarithmic scale. I thought I would try something new and ask for feedback on the change before I sprung it on the unsuspecting, but I heard nary a word from anyone, so I'm reverting to my usual "toss it at the wall and see if it sticks" method of debugging my programs.

cgContour -- A change I made to repair filled contour axes about 6 weeks ago was failing when multiple plots were involved, so I fixed that problem in this version.
