> I am not so fit in the ENVI programming, but as far I see you might have a problem with the file format in envi\_setup\_head. Writeu writes in a for loop first the 1st band, then the 2nd... Brian suggested in his code using Interleave=2 (BIP), I guess you should have 1 (BSQ), which you actually do, so we are not getting anywhere... :)
