Hi David,

you can check the relevant paths in IDL with 'print, !dlm\_path, getenv("LD\_LIBRARY\_PATH")'. LD\_LIBRARY\_PATH defines the search path for libcurl.so.

Also, you have at least two libcurl.so files, one in the system library and one in the IDL directory. Try to move the IDL version out of LD\_LIBRARY\_PATH.
