At one point there was a command line version for windows, what happened to it? I am now running IDL 8 on a Windows server 2008/R2 box, so can't implement some of the suggestions found on this forum, such as create a linux cron task. Rather not use the IDL 'wait' feature, would complicate other work. Many thanks!

I've been able to schedule non-IDL tasks on Windows 7 with Windows Scheduler. You'd have to create an executable of sorts, such as a .bat file with a call to IDL (that would work at the DOS window). Its worth Googling to see if this is viable.
