But, it doesn't appear to do anything. After a bit of googling, it sounds like this is a "feature" of the Mac window system. Can anyone confirm that that TLB_FRAME_ATTR does not work for Mac?

I think on X Windows systems, in general, the TLB frame attributes have always been treated as gentle "suggestions" (almost always ignored), rather than as strict commands.
